The food pantry esta abierto el primer y el tercer Jueves de cada mes

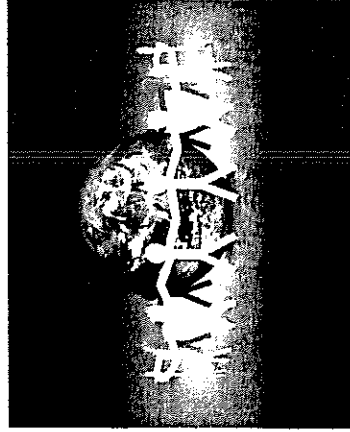

El Hebron Food Pantry esta asistido por la comunidad Iglesias, organizaciones locales, y ciudadanos privados.

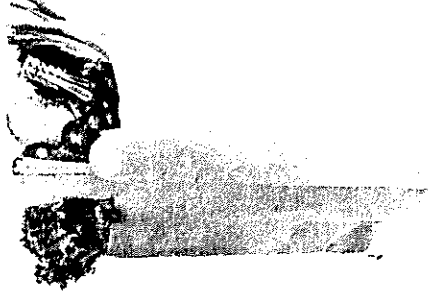

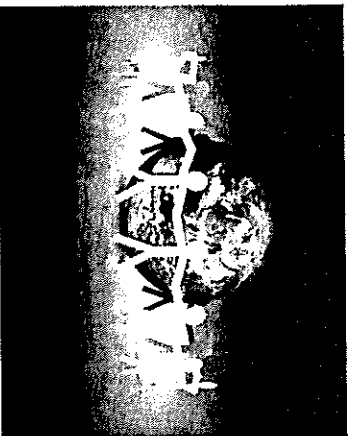

Food Pantry is located at the north end of Hebron, off Main Street on Freeman Road.

The Process:

- Clients are asked to fill out a confidential form that helps the food pantry track its resources
- Clients should be prepared to provide a name and birth date for each person receiving food in their household
- Families must reside in the Alden-Hebron School District
- Clients should bring proof of residency on first visit
- Only one family per household will be eligible

The food pantry is open the first and third Thursday of each month.
