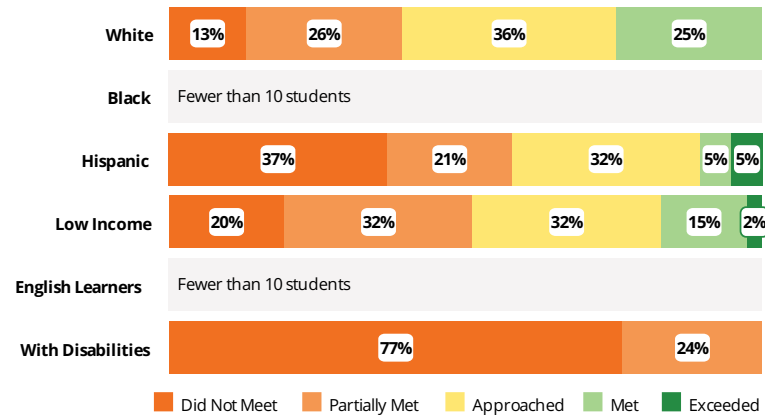
Academic Success

Success by Student Group

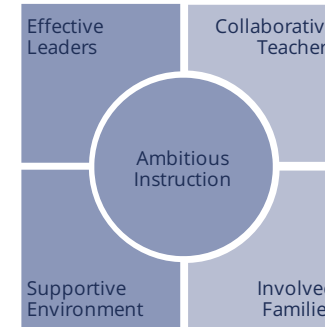
This display shows PARCC ELA performance levels for each student group. No data is shown for groups with fewer than 10 students.



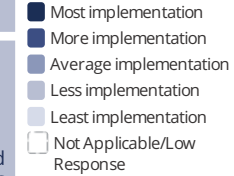

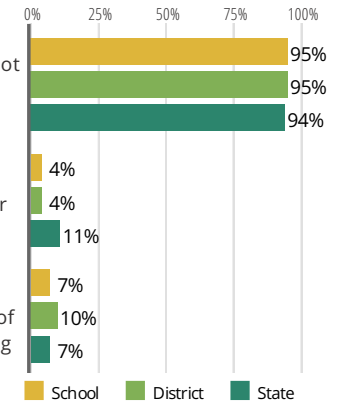

School Highlights

Academic Courses

Alden-Hebron Middle School students will have courses in Language Arts, Science, Social Studies, P.E., Math, as well as enrichment opportunities in Art, Band, Choir, Careers, Computers, and STEM. New to the building this year is Homework ICU. A homework completion program established to help students complete all homework assignments.

Physical Education, Health and Wellness

Alden-Hebron's Physical Education Program promotes team play, physical fitness, personal health, and nutrition. The physical education program also promotes the integration of other subject areas including ELA, Math, and Science.

Other Programs and Activities

Alden-Hebron Middle School is a school that promotes positive expectations for all students in varied settings. As a school there is an active student council which focuses on various activities throughout the school year that help promote social interaction amongst students. Homework club is available for students three days a week.

School Awards

Alden-Hebron Middle School placed first place in their conference's volleyball tournament. Student council was also selected to participate in a WE day campaign that focuses on community service locally and globally.

Career Development Courses and Programs

Alden-Hebron Middle School introduces students to a variety of career fields through the regular curriculum and enrichments. Areas of study include: U.S. economics, Careers and Consumerism, Computers, STEM, and guest speakers from a variety of fields including the military and engineering.

Athletics

Alden-Hebron Middle School provides students an opportunity to participate in the following athletic activities Boy's Basketball, Boy's Football, Boy's and Girl's Track and Field, Wrestling, Girl's Basketball, Girl's Volleyball, and Non-Competitive Cheer. All students are allowed to participate.

School Personnel Resources

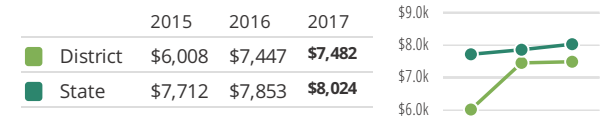

Facilities

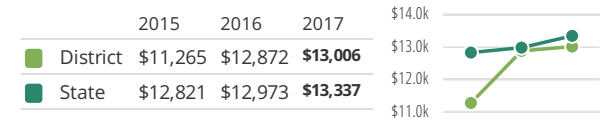
Alden-Hebron Middle School occupies the upstairs portion of Alden-Hebron MS/HS. The school itself has 7 classrooms and several shared facilities with the HS. A portion of the building was built in 1924 with an addition being added in 1956. Recent grant money has allowed the school to increase the amount of technology available for students.

District Finance

Instructional Spending per Pupil includes only the activities directly dealing with the teaching of students or the interaction between teachers and students.
